Fan into a flame the gift that God gave you

From time to time there is a powerful and striking message in the second reading at Mass, and this is certainly true today when we hear a short passage from St. Paul's second Letter to Timothy. Both of the letters contain helpful advice and there is a strong sense of mission in them.

In our passage for today Paul emphasises the gift of faith in Christ, in his resurrection, and in the mission he gives to the church and its members. His are tremendously encouraging words in the midst of difficulties. He reminds us that the gift has already been given, and we should resist timidity and doubt and put our gift (of faith) into practice, in whichever way the Spirit of God leads us.

Young people in our parish will soon be signing up for the course for the sacrament of Confirmation. I recently participated in the preparatory meeting for the catechists in the programme, and was struck by the energy and the "fire" within each of them. They show a remarkable commitment to give the best programme possible to our teenagers. Watch out for the link to the on-line application form, which will be available soon. I invite especially those between the ages of 14 –17 to think about their faith, and whether they want to join with others of their age for this preparation for the sacrament. Fr. Andrew
