## NEXT SUNDAY: World Mission Sunday

Next Sunday is World Mission Sunday. This movement is vital to the growth of the Church and the spread of the Gospel in predominantly impoverished and remote areas overseas. The funds raised build much-needed infrastructure, from chapels and schools to orphanages, clinics and dispensaries. Requested by the local community, the support from Missio transforms lives and creates a hub from which the young Church can flourish and grow. World Mission Sunday is one of only three Papal collections and has been especially chosen by the Holy Father to support the mission of the Church in the world.

During the recitation of the Hail Mary over each of the five decades we are invited to ponder on various mysteries in the life of Jesus and Mary: The Joyful Mysteries, the Sorrowful Mysteries, the Glorious Mysteries and the Luminous Mysteries.

Rosaries are available at economic rates in our Repository at the back of the church, as well as booklets about praying the rosary.

If you are able, please pray the Rosary each day, and join the parish community for Rosary, Monday to Saturday. (11am apart from Funeral days, when it immediately follows the 10am Mass.)
