Salvation comes to Zacchaeus' House and to ours

In the Gospel today Jesus puts out the hand of true friendship to Zacchaeus, a wealthy tax collector, a man hated by the Jews around him. Jesus holds out the same hope to each one of us, no matter how lost we are on our journey. Anyone can change because God never gives up on us, but is always out looking for us, calling us by name and wanting to make a home with us.

Coming to church today is like climbing a tree, hoping with Zacchaeus and one another to see Jesus. Hearing God's Word helps us to see ourselves better and to hear Jesus's desire to stay with us. Hearing Jesus' invitation helps us to change and become the joyful people who have heard the Good News and have embraced it.

Being a Christian isn't a private affair. We can't stay in the tree and just cherish Jesus' words and company. Zacchaeus took Jesus home with him and his family were the first beneficiaries of this grace-filled meeting with Jesus. He was a family man and a citizen of the world where he was to life and see others with new sight.

It is good to reflect on our attitude towards other people, and to pray for the grace to treat them in the way Jesus treats Zacchaeus.
