Second Sunday of Advent

Today is the Second Sunday of Advent, the time when we wait in hope and prayer for the celebration of the birth of Christ at Christmas. The reading from the prophet Isaiah carries the message of hopeful expectation for the people of

God, with the prophecy that in the end all will be well again. In the Gospel reading we meet John the Baptist for the first time. He is the last in a very long line of the biblical prophets, challenging the people for their lack of faith, and promising the coming of the Messiah. John's ministry is one of preaching repentance for sin, and of renewing our covenant with God in our baptism. The Advent season then is a time for reflection as we come to the end of a year, and to consider our own relationship through Christ to our heavenly Father. We are invited to confess our sins and to make a new start in that relationship. So please feel welcome to approach a priest for Confession, either after the 10am Mass each weekday, or at 6pm on Saturdays, or by appointment at the presbytery.
