COMMUNICATIONS SUNDAY

Today we pray for the all of the many people engaged in communicating the gospel and the values of our church teaching in all media around the world. It is more necessary than ever to proclaim contemporary church teaching to all those who need to hear it, and to challenge unjust structures and groups who care very little for the needs of God's people, especially the poor and all unjustly deprived of liberty, health care, and the resources necessary for life and education. Pope Francis' initiative, the Worldwide Prayer Network, has been a success is involving as many people as possible in the ministry of prayer and support. In his message to mark the day, Pope Francis stresses the need to listen before speaking truth with a pure heart to "see beyond appearances and overcome the vague din which, in the field of information, does not help us discern in the complicated world in which we live." The Holy Father, warning against indifference and indignation, hails the example of the great Doctor of the Church, St Francis de Sales, in particular his commitment to patient, heartfelt dialogue. A gifted theologian, his phrase 'Heart speaks to heart' inspired many, none more so than the recently canonised Saint John Henry Newman, who chose the phrase as his cardinalial motto, 'Cor ad cor loquitur'. Catholics in England and Wales will remember with affection that 'Heart speaks unto heart' was also the theme for Pope Benedict XVI's historic visit to the UK in 2010. *There is a retiring collection today to support the church's ongoing communication ministry. Thank you for your generosity.*
