Let each one of us prepare for and look forward to the spiritual
atmosphere of Holy Week, leading to the Easter Triduum. From
Holy Thursday until Easter Sunday we will live the central days of
the Liturgical Year, celebrating the mystery of the Passion, Death
and Resurrection of the Lord. And we live this mystery every time
we celebrate the Eucharist. When we go to Mass, we do not go on-
ly to pray, no: we go to renew, to bring about again, this mystery,
the Paschal mystery. It is important not to forget this. It is as
though we were to go to Calvary – it is the same – to renew, to

2023/24 necessary church repairs:

Asbestos removal from boiler room: £12,648

Electric system obligatory replacement: £5,900

Fire alarm system (required by insurance): £9,390

Heating: Repairs to broken pipe and re-commission of the boilers: £3,779
