PEACE BE WITH YOU

This Easter time reminds us that each of us can start all over again. We are offered forgiveness again for our sins, for our half-hearted attempts at change, and for our fear of death that keeps us locked up in feeble attempts at self-preservation.

The disciples, who heard the risen Christ instruct them to go out and proclaim "repentance for the forgiveness of sins," knew that they themselves had been the first beneficiaries of the message they were to proclaim. Jesus forgave them first, and so they must forgive others. Remember the Our Father prayer: "forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." All that had passed before---their betraval and abandonments of

Christ in his suffering---had been forgiven by Jesus' greeting to them, "Peace be to you."

They would be ambassadors proclaiming that peace to "all nations." They weren't to wallow in their past sins, they had been "wiped away." Now they had to announce the same possibilities to others.

We are called to follow in their footsteps and to be Christians to others, to proclaim our belief in the risen Lord and to continue to pass on the message of the Good News to everyone we meet. We pray for the courage and strength to carry out the wishes of the Lord during the coming week.

Next Sunday: Good Shepherd Sunday

Next Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday, the day we pray for priests and for vocations to the priesthood. The annual collection for the Priest Training Fund will take place next weekend. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic diocesan priesthood. There are currently 49 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 13 of whom are from our own Diocese. We also have one seminarian in Valladolid and one at the Beda, presently on pastoral placement in Ruislip. There are also two on a propaedeutic year at Redemptoris Mater. Last year 3 deacons were ordained for Westminster Diocese. The Priest Training Fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests.
